On April 4-6, 2018 Ireland's city of Galway has hosted The 11th International Conference on Theory and Practice of Electronic Governance (ICEGOV). ICEGOV is a series of conferences, which brings together participants from across the world every year at different locations to discuss e-Governance aspects, current major directions and challenges and share the best practices of those countries with long track record of success in implementing e-Governance models. ICEGOV is organized and coordinated by UNU-EGOV, part of the United Nations University (UNU) based in the city of Guimarães, Portugal.

From Georgia, **Natalia Goderdzishvili**, Head of Legal Division at Data Exchange Agency of the Ministry of Justice of Georgia participated in the conference. Mrs. Goderdzishvili, on the first day of the event, in the format of panel discussions, introduced the audience to the achievements of Georgia's successful journey to e-Governance development.

Particularly, she spoke about the country's digital transformation and reviewed Georgia's approaches in successfully implementing e-Governance platforms, as well as fostering public service delivery and making the use of ICTs in the process of public administration (Continued on P. 2).

the most popular forms in online trading.

Mobile application of the website www.eAuction.ge is available on App Store and Google Play and can be downloaded free of charge.

Mobile application integrates the following key modules of the website:

- Registration/Authorization/Password recovery;
- Payment/Participation in a bidding;
- Search for the current lots/filtration.

In addition, online payment system is incorporated in the mobile application and traders are enabled to make a payment of any kind defined by the auction rules remotely at a time and place of their convenience (Continued on P. 3).
